

Automatic System for TRacking E-Learners

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ASTRE Project Overview

In recent years, Europe has witnessed a rapid and massive expansion of e-learning courses. An increasing number of adults follow e-learning courses and MOOCs, with different motivations. This increase in the number of enrolments in MOOCs and e-learning, as well as the increase in the number of courses offered that fall under this type of learning, makes it necessary to have qualitative and quantitative information on the impact of the MOOCs and e-learning courses, on learners' personal and professional competences. The ASTRE project developed results that make it possible to solve the lack of data and information on MOOC training.

TRACKING SYSTEM FOR MOOC LEARNERS

The first output developed by the project partners is a tracking system for MOOC learners. The tracking system measures the benefit and the impact of attendance of e-learning courses, in learners with different motivations and different degree of engagement and supports the quality assurance and strategic planning of the providers.

The second output developed by the ASTRE project is a methodological guide for MOOC providers which supports them in setting up a permanent tracking system and integrate it, into the quality assurance system of their organisation. ASTRE Final Mini Conference

The **ASTRE Final Mini Conference**, was organized in Cyprus on the **14th January 2022**, hosted by the European Association of Erasmus Coordinators (EAEC). The event took place at the UNESCO Amphitheater, University of Nicosia.

During the conference, the partners presented the tracking system for MOOC and e-learning graduates, the methodological guide addressed to MOOC providers and the results from the tracking system pilots in Spain, Italy, Greece and Germany. In addition, they stressed, the importance of the integration of a tracking system for MOOC and e-learner graduates in the quality assurance system of MOOC and e-learning providers.
